It has come to our attention that some people are looking into the possibility of using portable buildings as 'tiny houses'. With that in mind, there are some regulations that you should be aware of as you consider this trendy and economical option.

Jackson County Planning and Zoning (all areas except Seymour and Brownstown) requires that any structure larger than 200 SqFt apply for an improvement (building) permit. The structure will also need to meet all requirements for size, setbacks, elevation, etc. Seymour requirements are basically the same. Call Jeremy Grey at 812-522-4020 for more information.

Jackson County Code and the Jackson County Health Department requires that any structure, regardless of size, that has running (potable) water has a method of waste water disposal, whether that be sanitary sewer, where available, or an onsite (sewage) system.

Please keep these regulations in mind as you plan your building's location and use.
